## Positively Scrappy

Precut Scrap Block Series
Beginner Friendly
Make this fun 8 ½" plus block (9" unfinished) using your precut scraps or your scrap stash!

## Fabric Requirements

## Color Fabric

O (1) $5^{\prime \prime}$ square
O (4) $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

## Background Fabric

O (4) $21 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares

## Block Construction

1. Take (2) $21 / 2 "$ background squares and (1) $21^{1 / 2 \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sew, with right sides together (RST), the background squares to opposite ends of the colored rectangle. Press toward the color fabric. Repeat to make a total of 2 units. See Diagram 1.
2. Take the remaining (2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and sew, RST, to opposite sides of the 5" color square. Press toward rectangles. See Diagram 2.
3. Sew, RST, the units from step one to opposite sides of the center square unit made in step two. Seams will nest. Press toward center. See Diagram 3.
