Make this fun 8 ½" plus block (9" unfinished) using your precut scraps or your scrap stash!

Fabric Requirements

Color Fabric


- O (1) 5" square
- O (4) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 5" rectangles

Background Fabric

O (4) 2 1/2" squares

Block Construction

- 1. Take (2) 2 1/2" background squares and (1) 2 ½" x 5" rectangle. Sew, with right sides together (RST), the background squares to opposite ends of the colored rectangle. Press toward the color fabric. Repeat to make a total of 2 units. See Diagram 1.
- 2. Take the remaining (2) 2 1/2" x 5" rectangles and sew, RST, to opposite sides of the 5" color square. Press toward rectangles. See Diagram 2.
- 3. Sew, RST, the units from step one to opposite sides of the center square unit made in step two. Seams will nest. Press toward center. See Diagram 3.





